## Kawaii Tokyo Experience (3-day & 5-day Itinerary)

### [Kawaii Day 1]

- 9:00 – 10:00: Get ready / breakfast from kombini (7-eleven, FamilyMart, Lawson, New-days)

- 10:00 – 12:00: **Harajuku** (via Yamanote Line)
  - Takeshita Street, LaForet, Toy Sapiens (for toy collectors), KIDDYLAND Harajuku
  - Recommended vintage fashion select stores: FUNKTIQUE Tokyo, PINNAP, PUNK CAKE, Bubbles Harajuku
- 12:00 – 1:00: Lunch @ Harajuku
  - Suggestions:
    - Pancake Days (must line up)
    - Heiroke Sushi Omotesando (must line up!)
    - Kyushu Jangara Ramen (must line up!)
    - Sakura Tei Okonomiyaki (must line up!)
    - Tonkatsu Maisen
    - Jonathan's (try their matcha desserts!)
    - Cafe Kaila (must line up!)
- 1:30 – 3:00: **Shibuya** (via Yamanote Line)
  - Purikura, UFO machine, Hachiko Statue, Shibuya Crossing, Tower Records, LoFT, Village Vanguard, Shibuya 109 mall, Tokyu Hands
- 3:30 – 5:00: **Shimo-kitazawa** (via Keio)

Inokashira Line)

- Check this article: Cafes worth the visit when in Shimo-kita
- Visit Brokendoll Shop, shop at Village Vanguard, take lots of photos. This is a very pretty neighborhood!
- 5:30 – 7:00: **Shinjuku** (via Keio Inokashira Line)
  - Calico Cat Cafe, Laduree, Kinokuniya Bookstore, Bikkuro (Uniqlo + Bic Camera), Nikon (for photography enthusiasts)
  - Alternative: Shin-Okubo / Korean Town (if you are also into KPOP and you want to visit Korea in Japan, hehe)
    - From Shinjuku, take the Yamanote line. It is just one stop.

[Kawaii Day 2]

- 9:00 – 10:00: Get ready / breakfast from kombini (7-eleven, FamilyMart, Lawson, New-days)
- 10:00 – 1:00: Ghibli Museum in Mitaka or Do-raemon Museum in Kawasaki
  - Please calculate your arrival time be-

cause the Japanese are always on time. If your Ghibli museum ticket is 10:00 am, please be there by 9:45 am at the least.

- 1:00 – 3:00: **Tokyo** (via Yamanote Line)
  - Tokyo Imperial Palace, Tokyo Station (Tokyo Character Street for your kawaii merchandise needs)
- 3:30 – 5:00: **Ueno** (via Yamanote Line)
  - You can shop at Ameyokocho, visit the museum / Ueno park ~
- 5:30 onwards: **Akihabara** (via Yamanote Line)
  - Yodobashi Camera, Kotobukiya, Don Quijote, Maid cafe (@homecafe / maidream-in), Gundam cafe, Animate, etc.

### [Kawaii Day 3]

- Option 1: Tokyo Disneyland
- Option 2: Tokyo Disney Sea
- Option 3: **Ginza, Asakusa & Tokyo Sky Tree**
- Option 4: Sanrio Puroland & Tokyo Tower (extra)

Spend the whole day at Odaiba, Tokyo.

- Morning: Odaiba DECKS Mall
  - Access guide
  - Attractions: Legoland, Tokyo Trick Art Museum, Odaiba Takoyaki Museum
- Afternoon: DiverCity Tokyo Plaza & Palette Town
  - Palette Town Attractions: Rainbow daikanransha / ferris wheel
  - DiverCity Attractions: Life-size Gundam, tax-free premium shops, Japan-themed goods shops (Rainbow Pocky, Hello Kitty)
- Evening: AQUA City Odaiba
  - Attractions: Rainbow Bridge View, AQUA City Odaiba mall itself, and more.
  - Alternative: Venus Fort
